



## WorkPapers.Pro Announces Web Application Release – Revolutionizing Audit Working Papers

Yokohama, Japan (September 1, 2010) – WorkPapers.Pro (<http://workpapers.pro>), the creator of the original WorkPapers electronic audit working papers program, today announced the formal release of a new electronic working papers web application – the first cloud solution for audit professionals.

WorkPapers’ natural project workflow and low learning curve makes it the ideal tool for busy seasoned audit professionals or junior auditors still getting used to audit work challenges.

Traditional electronic working papers require auditors to engage in extensive training to use the tools, usually including additional required training to learn approaches, methodologies, and other specialized knowledge. WorkPapers.Pro eliminates this requirement and enables immediate productivity by offering a tool that fosters the audit approach and planning through checklist and template management. The framework is up to the individual practitioner or audit practice and is not enforced in the WorkPapers.Pro tool – making it the only universal audit program manager, audit documentation manager, and audit template tool currently available to auditors.

WorkPapers.Pro currently offers the following features with an expanding feature list as the web application is under continuous development:

- Attach external documents
- Link emails
- Project sharing and limited access control
- Template export and import
- Export all data to PDF or RTF (more formats coming soon)

The development plan continues with improved email integration, Google Docs integration, and a dedicated report creation module coming in fourth quarter of 2010.

“Traditional electronic working papers require a high and steep learning curve, cost an exorbitant amount for licensing, then enforce a specific methodology on the practitioner. It’s about time we created an affordable tool for the practitioner that can be quickly implemented to existing projects, has a low training requirement, and actually fosters the planning, evidence gathering, and reporting process,” commented Kirt Cathey, the author of WorkPapers desktop software and WorkPapers.Pro. “WorkPapers.Pro offers the very features that a practitioner needs to deliver consistent results through improved planning with a template import/export feature in an affordable package.”

WorkPapers.Pro has been in beta for the past six months, originally created from the code base the original WorkPapers desktop software that connects to a variety of relational databases.

WorkPapers.Pro is open for registration, including a starter full-featured free version that allows practitioners to try the features with limited storage capability; paid subscriptions are available from \$17.95 per month, and custom intranet installation options are available upon inquiry.
